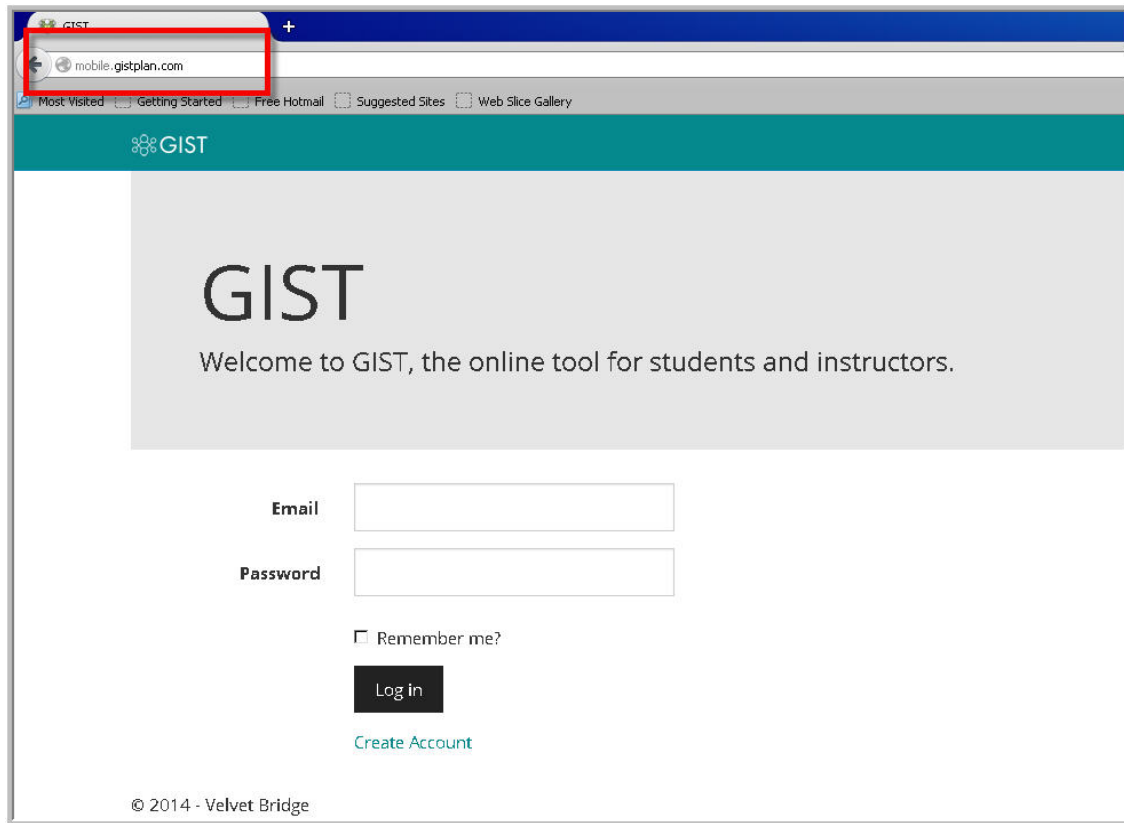
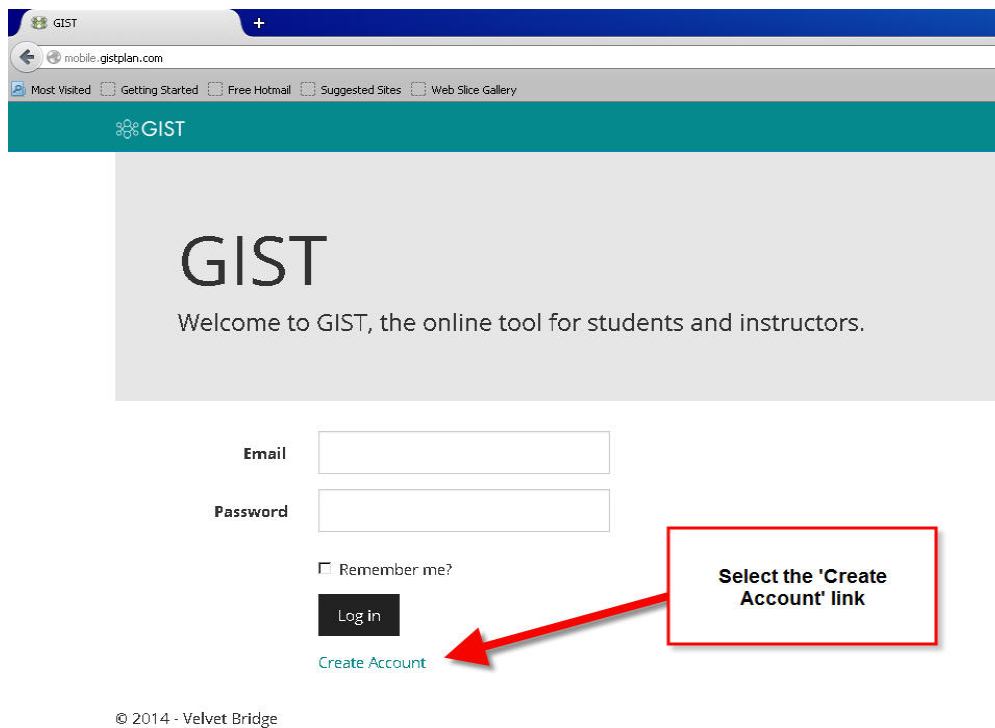


GIST Mobile Account Creation and Subscription Activation


1. Start by going to mobile.gistplan.com. Create a GIST fav icon on IPADs and Tablet by selecting the 'Add To Home Screen option'.



2. On the GIST Mobile sign in page select the 'Create Account' link.




3. Teachers that already have a gistplan.com account from downloading the GIST software and related products can sign in with email and password. Teachers and Students that don't have gistplan.com account will need to create new accounts so they can activate their GIST Mobile subscription.



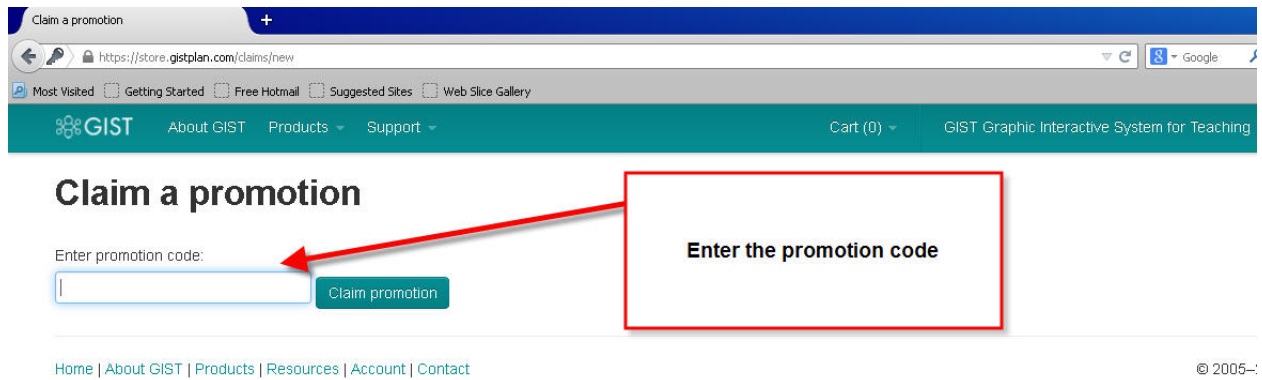

4. When creating a new account it's important that Teachers and Students select the correct Account type so that the appropriate GIST Mobile subscription is activated. Note: A teacher GIST Mobile Account and Subscription is a very different than a GIST Mobile Student account and includes a lot more functionality. Teacher accounts have the ability to create student accounts.

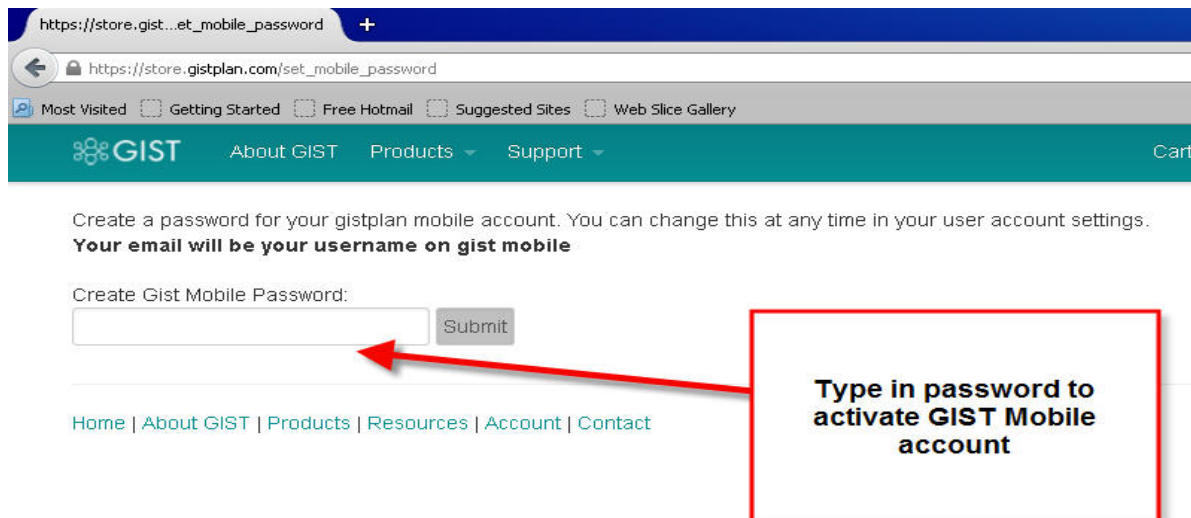

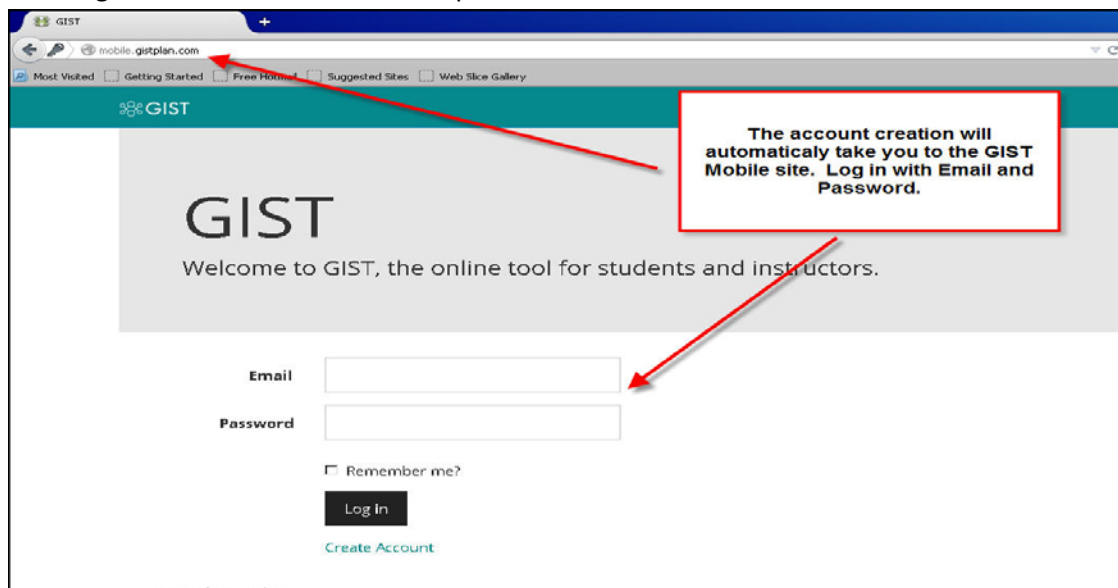
5. Once an account has been created, go to the 'Claim a promotion' page - <https://store.gistplan.com/claims/new>



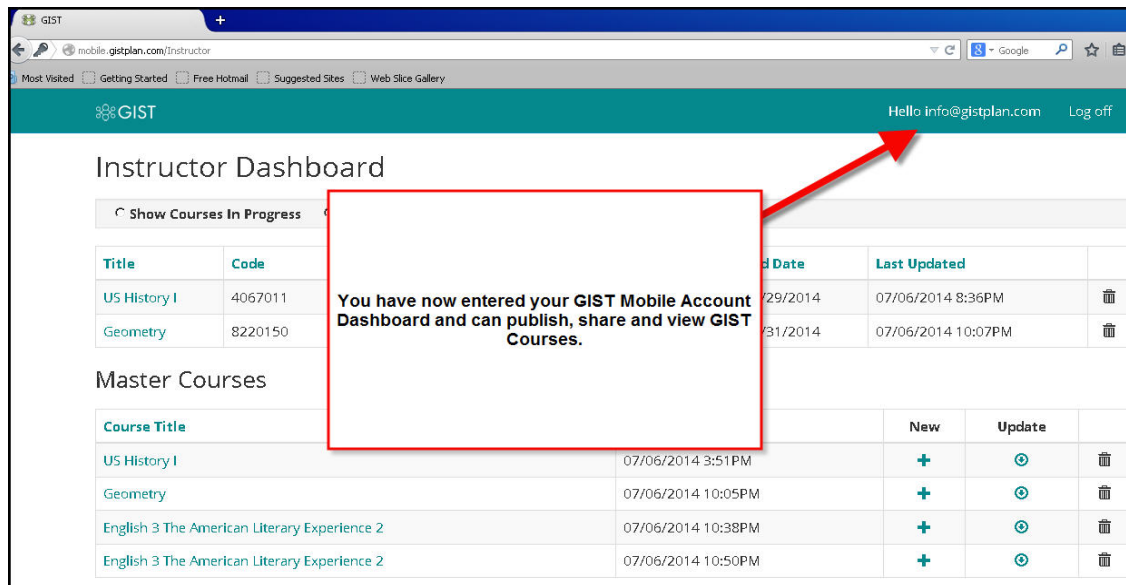
6. A GIST Mobile promotion will automatically direct you to the Create GIST Mobile Password. Enter a password for confirmation that you want to activate GIST Mobile account and year subscription.



7. After you type in a password and select the 'Submit' button, the link will take you to the GIST Mobile site. Log in to the site with email and password.



8. Once logged on to 'Insturctor Dashboard' the GIST Mobile account is activated and the users email should appear in right corner of screen. The teacher can now publish, view, share, update and add students to their Content Enhancement Course.



9. Once logged on to 'Student Dashboard' the GIST Mobile account is activated and the student account name or email address should appear in the right corner. Students can now view, naviage, co-create, take notes, obtain assignments, give feedback and particapte in the development of a Content Enhancement Course.
