

GIST syncing with Teachers IO & My Homework

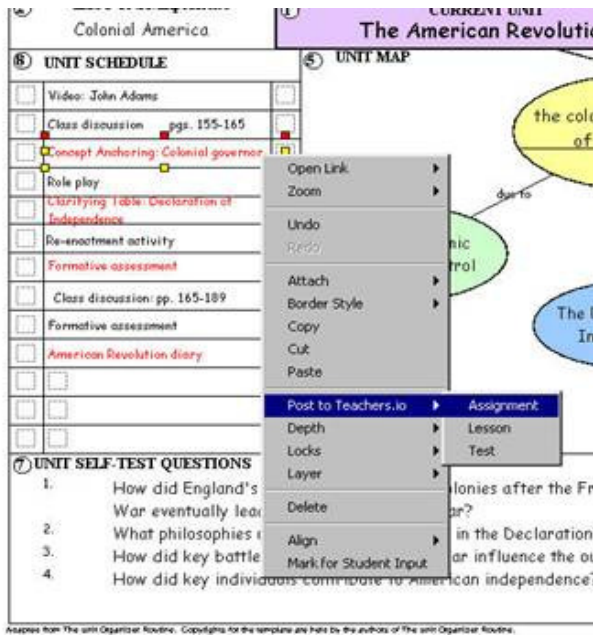
In GISTv2 any text box or shape(Text Lists don't apply) can be used to sync an assignment, test, lesson or other information with Teacher IO and My Homework.

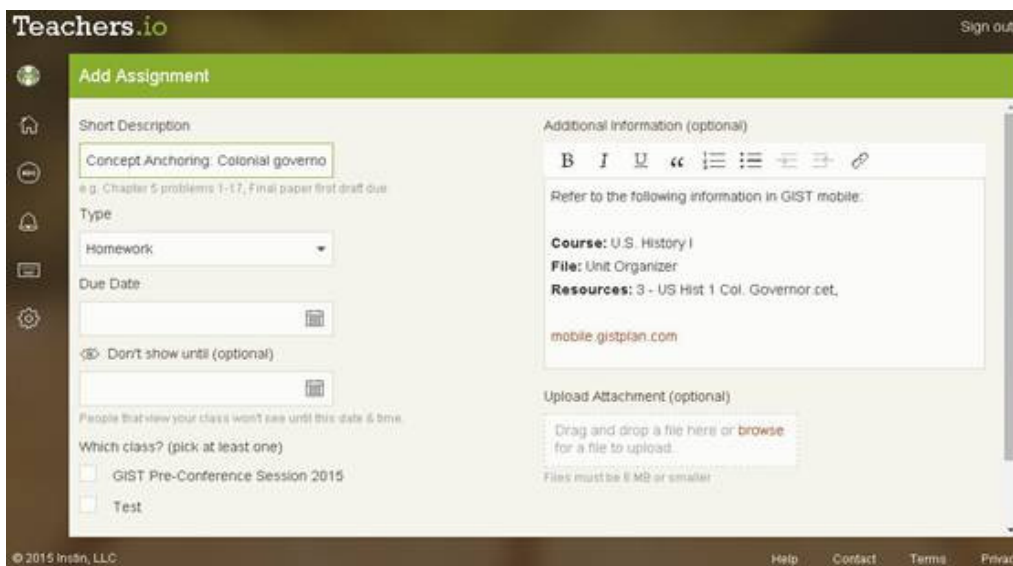

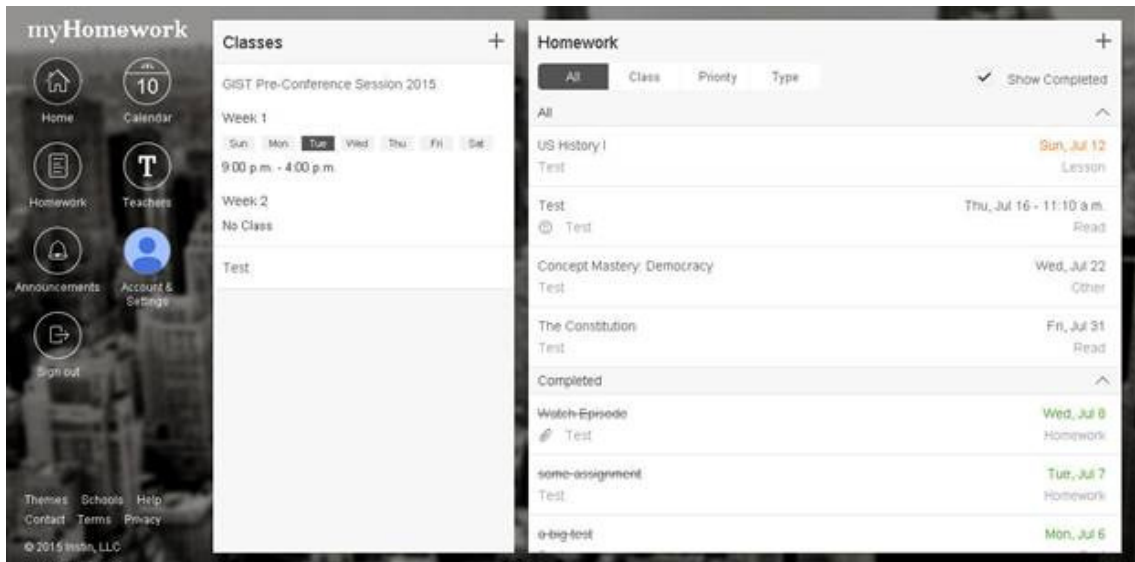
2. Next, scroll down to the 'Post to Teacher.io' menu option and select from one of three sub-menu items which include 'Assignment', 'Test' or 'Lesson'.



3. After one of three of the 'Post to Teachers.io' options have been selected, a web browser will open going directly to Teacher e (<https://teachers.io/>). If a user already has a Teacher IO account and is logged on, the information from GIST will automatically appear in the 'Add Assignment' window including Course(if applicable) file type and description name.



4. Add a 'Due Date' and select the Class to share the Assignment. Select the 'Add' button and the 'Assignment' will have been added to the 'Class'.



In My Homework, the student can select the 'Assignment' and add additional information and notes.



Students can also view the My Homework Tasks and Assignments via 'Calendar'.
